

## NSS Report

**1. 27/09/2023:** A Dengue Fever Awareness Camp was conducted on the college campus with the participation of forty NSS members and several other college students. As part of the programme, a comprehensive cleaning drive was carried out across the campus, including the buildings, bathrooms, and dustbins, to help prevent the spread of Dengue.



**2. 03/10/2023:** A campus cleaning and Dengue awareness programme was conducted on this day at the college campus. A total of forty-five NSS & NCC members, along with other college students, actively participated in the initiative. After the cleaning activities, bleaching powder was applied throughout the campus as a preventive measure against the spread of Dengue.



**3. 04/01/2024:** A quiz competition was organized by the NSS Unit at Alipurduar Girls' College. In this event, teams comprising five NSS members from various colleges participated enthusiastically. A team representing the NSS Unit of Alipurduar College also took part in the

competition. Certificates of participation were distributed to all the participants at the end of the programme.



4. 06/01/2024: On this day, a campus cleaning programme was organized by the NSS Unit. The NSS members actively cleaned various areas both inside and outside the college campus. After the cleaning, bleaching powder was applied to ensure proper sanitation and hygiene.



5. 15/01/2024: On this day, a blood donation camp was organized on the college campus. All NSS Unit-I members actively participated in the programme. In addition to the NSS Unit-I, the NCC unit of the college and Vaidik Samaj, a voluntary organization based in Alipurduar, also



took part in the event. A total of 45 units of blood were collected during the camp, reflecting the enthusiastic participation and commitment of all involved.



**6. 05/06/2024**

*Activity 1 (Tree Plantation on World Environment Day, 5<sup>th</sup> June 2024)-*

On the World Environment Day, we have planted trees (Debdaru, Meheguni etc.) at the newly constructed Girls' Hostel area of the college as a joint initiative of the Geography Department and NSS. The Principal of the college, faculty members, non-teaching staffs, and members of NSS were present on this day. We also planted trees in surrounding areas outside the college campus.



**7. 21/06/2024**

*Activity 2 (Yoga Day Celebration on International Day of Yoga, 21<sup>st</sup> June 2024)-*

On the occasion of International Day of Yoga, NSS and NCC unit of the institution jointly organized Yoga sessions at the campus and encouraged everyone to participate. More than 80 students participated and the programme was held for 2 hours (9 am to 11 am) where different types of yoga were practiced.







**8. 11/09/2024:** On this day, a conference on AIDS Awareness was jointly organized by the NSS Unit-I of Alipurduar College and the Chief Medical Health Office (CMHO) in the seminar hall of the college, from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM. The event was graced by the Respected Registrar of Alipurduar University, two AIDS specialists from the CMHO, as well as students and faculty members of the institution. The two specialists provided detailed insights into the symptoms, transmission, and prevention of AIDS, engaging the audience through an interactive question-and-answer session. The conference significantly contributed to raising awareness about the disease among all participants.





**9. 17/09/2024:** “Swachhata Hi Seva-2024” programme was conducted from 17<sup>th</sup> September to 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2024 on the college campus. As part of this initiative, the NSS Unit-I carried out a campus cleaning drive on 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> September. On 24<sup>th</sup> September, NSS Day was celebrated with a tree plantation programme, during which fifty trees were planted across various locations within the campus. To ensure the protection of the newly planted trees, they were covered with protective nets on 25<sup>th</sup> September.





**10. 18/11/2024:** An educational survey was conducted from 18<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> November by the NSS Unit-I of Alipurduar College, in collaboration with the ASRA Group. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between the two organizations to formalize this partnership. To ensure the successful execution of the survey, a seven-day training program was conducted



for the NSS members in the seminar hall of Alipurduar College. Following the training, 15 teams comprising NSS volunteers were formed and deployed to various villages across the Alipurduar district. Each team conducted the survey over a period of two days and subsequently submitted their detailed reports. The final compiled report was published by Prothom Foundation and circulated across India.







## **11. 11/02/2025**

The cleanliness drive programme as per the “Swachhata Action Plan” (NSS/RD/KOL/2024-2025) has been conducted at the campus on the 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of February 2025. Details of the program are given below.

### **Activity-1 (Poster Painting Competition, 11<sup>th</sup> February 2025):**

A painting competition was organized on the campus from 12 noon to 2 pm on this day. Thirty participants, including NSS members and students of the institute, took part. Of these, 15 students created paintings focused on environmental awareness. Afterward, they discussed their topics in detail. At the end, a group photo was taken with all the participants and their poster paintings.

### **Activity-2 (Campus Cleaning Programme, 11<sup>th</sup> February 2025):**

After the poster painting competition, the NSS members collect garbage, plastic waste, and other debris from the areas outside the campus and dispose of them in designated dustbins. The program ends once this activity is completed.

### **Activity-3 (Organization of Seminar, 12<sup>th</sup> February 2025):**

On the second day, a seminar on the role of students in environmental awareness was organized from 12 noon to 2 pm. Sri Binoy Kumar, Regional Director of NSS Kolkata, was scheduled to present at the event. However, due to unavoidable circumstances, he was unable to attend. Dr. Jyotsna Das, Associate Professor in the Botany Department at Alipurduar University, and Dr. Edwin Penjor Bhutia, Associate Professor in the Geography Department at Alipurduar University, were present and delivered speeches on the topic. We believe the participants were enriched by their insights. The program concluded with a question-and-answer session.

### **Activity-4 (Organization of Rally, 12<sup>th</sup> February 2025):**



After the seminar, a rally was conducted with all the NSS members inside and outside the campus area. After the rally, the program concluded.

#### Activity-5 (Organization of Seminar, 25<sup>th</sup> February 2025):

Sri Binoy Kumar, Regional Director of NSS Kolkata, could not attend the seminar on 12<sup>th</sup> February. However, he expressed his wish to deliver a lecture on NSS, specifically on the topic "Orientation Programme and Youth for My Bharat." In the seminar, apart from the chief guest, Sri Binoy Kumar, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of Alipurduar University, Prof. Sarit Kumar Chaudhuri, and the IQAC Director of Alipurduar University, Dr. Ranjit Kumar Ghosh, were present. During the program, Sri Binoy Kumar sir detailed discussion inspired the students. Following this, Dr. Ranjit Kumar Ghosh presented his speech on NSS. Then, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. Sarit Kumar Chaudhuri shared his views on how students can take a more effective role in NSS. The program concluded with a vote of thanks.

## NSS Special Camp- 2025

### Report

Organized by Alipurduar University, erstwhile Alipurduar College

NSS of Alipurduar University, erstwhile Alipurduar College has organized a special camp-2025 for seven days. All the details of the activities are given below-

#### 1<sup>st</sup> day

Date: 4<sup>th</sup> April 2025

Topic: Inauguration and orientation

Details: The programme commenced at 9:00 AM with the flag hoisting ceremony of the National Service Scheme (NSS) and the lighting of the ceremonial lamp in the presence of NSS members of Alipurduar University (formerly Alipurduar College), along with other students and faculty members. This was followed by the rendition of the National Anthem at 9:30 AM. Breakfast was served at 9:45 AM. Registration for the event began at 10:00 AM. A detailed discussion on NSS activities took place from 11:00 AM onwards, involving members and concerned stakeholders. At 10:00 AM, the members proceeded to Damanpur Primary School, which falls under the Subarnapur Colony Gram Panchayat, near Alipurduar town. There, a cleanliness drive was conducted, including the application of bleaching powder in and around the school premises to promote hygiene and sanitation. Following the cleaning activity, a discussion on environmental awareness was held to sensitize participants and local residents about the importance of maintaining a clean and sustainable environment. At 3:00 PM, a tree plantation programme was carried out as part of the initiative to promote green and eco-friendly practices. The programme concluded successfully after the plantation drive.

Date: 6<sup>th</sup> April 2025

Topic: Health awareness and eye camp

At 10:00 AM, a health camp was organized at Subarnapur, where various healthcare services & educational survey were provided to local residents. Starting from 11:00 AM, a free eye check-up session was conducted as part of the camp. A large number of people from the surrounding areas actively participated in this initiative. In total, 90 individuals underwent eye examinations. Free eye drops were distributed based on the needs identified during the check-up. The eye check-up continued until 4:00 PM, after which a group discussion was held at 4:30 PM, marking the conclusion of the day's programme.







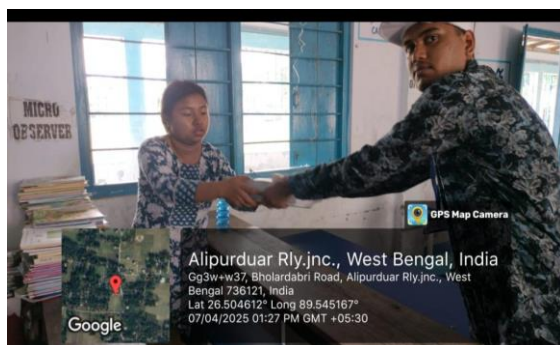
#### 4<sup>th</sup> Day

## 5<sup>th</sup> Day

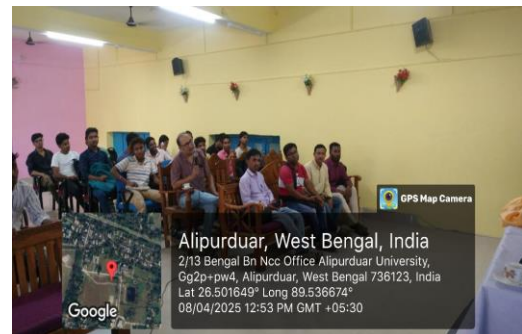
Date: 8<sup>th</sup> April 2025

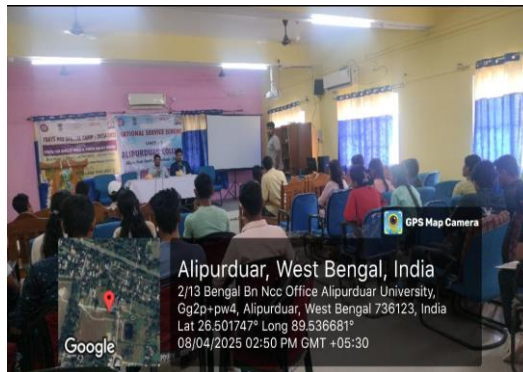
Topic: Skill development and digital literacy
