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Three Discipline Specific (Multidisciplinary) Course (B.A./ B.Com./ B.Sc.)

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1. Eligibility Criteria for Admission in Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP): Single Major and Single Minor
- i. A student shall be allowed to take admission in the Single Major and Single Minor Program of B.A. /B.Sc./B.Com. if he/ she/transgender has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Examination which is recognized by the University.
- ii. Provided that a candidate who has obtained- (a) 55% marks in the aggregate, or (b) 50% in the aggregate with 60% marks in a subject / related subject in the last qualifying Examination shall be eligible to apply for Single Major and Single Minor Program in that subject.
- iii. A candidate must obtain 55% marks in the aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.
- iv. For SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PWD candidates- the minimum marks for eligibility shall be as per Rules of the State Government.
- v. Provided further that in matter of eligibility 54.5% marks or above shall be equal to 55%, 49.5% and above shall be equal to 50% and 59.5 marks or above shall be equal to 60%.
- vi. Admission shall be on the basis of merit and availability of seats.
- vii. Candidates who have been passed H.S. or equivalent examination in the last 3 years will be considered.
- 2. Eligibility Criteria for Admission in Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP): Three Discipline Specific Multidisciplinary Program

A student shall be allowed to take admission in the Multidisciplinary Program of B.A. /B.Com / B.Sc. if he/she/transgender has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other Examination which is recognized by the University as equivalent thereto.

A candidate shall be allowed to pursue B.A./B. Com./B.Sc. Multidisciplinary Program if he/she/transgender has passed the qualifying Examination in Vocational Stream subjects, however, such students shall have the option to study up to the end of 6th semester.

3. Choice of Courses for Single Major and Single Minor Program Criteria

Criteria to choose Major Course

- A candidate will be allowed to take up **Bengali** subject as Major if he/she has passed in Bengali at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up **English** subject as Major if he/she has passed in English at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up **History** subject as Major if he/she has passed in History or any other subjects at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up **Philosophy** subject as Major if he/she has passed in Philosophy or any other subjects at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up **Political Science** subject as Major if he/she has passed in Political Science or any other subjects at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up **Geography** subject as Major if he/she has passed in Geography at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up **Economics** subject as Major if he/she has passed in Mathematics or Applied Mathematics or Business Economics including Business Mathematics, and other subjects as prescribed at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up **Sanskrit** subject as Major if he/she has passed in Sanskrit at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up **Physics** Subject as Major if he/she has passed in Mathematics and Chemistry along with Physics and other subject as prescribed at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up **Chemistry** Subject as Major if he/she has passed in Mathematics and Physics along with Chemistry and other subject as prescribed at the qualifying examination.

- A candidate will be allowed to take up **Mathematics** Subject as Major if he/she has passed in Physics and Chemistry or Statistics or Computer Science along with Mathematics and other subject as prescribed at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up **Botany** Subject as Major if he/she has passed in Biology at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up **Zoology** Subject as Major if he/she has passed in Biology at the qualifying examination.
- A candidate will be allowed to take up **Accounting & Finance as Major** B.Com. if he/she has studied accountancy, or Science subjects along with Mathematics in the previous qualifying exams.
